ACADEMICS

In academics session 2023-2024, our students brought 100% result both in grade X and grade XII.

EXAMINATIONS/ASSESSMENTS

PREMIDTERM examinations for classes VI to XII and Assessment I for classes I TO V were conducted as per the decided schedule in July. Midterm examination and half yearly were conducted in the month of October and Post midterm was conducted in the month of December. For X & XII grades model exams conducted in January. Various activities and design plans organize for the improvement of Handwriting, special measures were taken for Spoken English.It was the idea of our Manager Adv.M A Jabbar to introduce Accenta groups for

the enhancement of Spoken English .He declared a special LECTIOPHILE award to encourage children for promoting maximum reading.

OTHER COMPETATIVE EXAMINATIONS

Competitive exams like Science Talent test from grade VI were conducted. Aryabhatta talent test conducted by CBSE .51 participated and 3 qualified for second round .H & C All Kerala Quiz Competition for grade VI,VII & VIII was conducted and 77 children participated and 3 of them qualified for next level. Two awarded with cash cheques. Students also participated for Pravasi Quiz for high school and qualified for next level.

INVESTITURE CEREMONY

Our School always promote students participation in administration to inculcate the administrative quality among the students .So the students cabinet was installed in a befitting manner with an investiture ceremony on 15th August .Under the guidance of the teachers they assist in the day to day activities of the school.
